<b>FFMPEG</b>	FFmpeg is a complete solution to record, convert and stream audio and video. It includes libavcodec, the leading audio/video codec library. <b>FLAC</b>	FLAC stands for Free Lossless Audio Codec, an audio format similar to MP3, but lossless, meaning that audio is compressed in FLAC without any loss in quality. FLAC stands out as the fastest and most widely supported lossless audio codec, and the only one that at once is non-proprietary, is unencumbered by patents, has an open-source reference implementation, has a well documented format and API, and has several other independent implementations.	<a href="http://flac.sourceforge.net">http://flac.sourceforge.net</a>
<b>IMAGEMAGICK</b>	Imagemagick is a set of programs to manipulate various image formats (JPEG, TIFF, PhotoCD, PBM, XPM, etc...). All manipulations can be achieved through shell commands as well as through an X11 graphical interface (display). Possible effects: colormap manipulation, channel operations, thumbnail creation, image annotation, limited drawing, image distortion, etc...	<a href="http://www.imagemagick.org">http://www.imagemagick.org</a>
<b>SOX</b>	SOX (SOund eXchange) is a generic utility for translating sound files from one format to another, possibly performing a sound effect at the same time.
